## Empowering women!

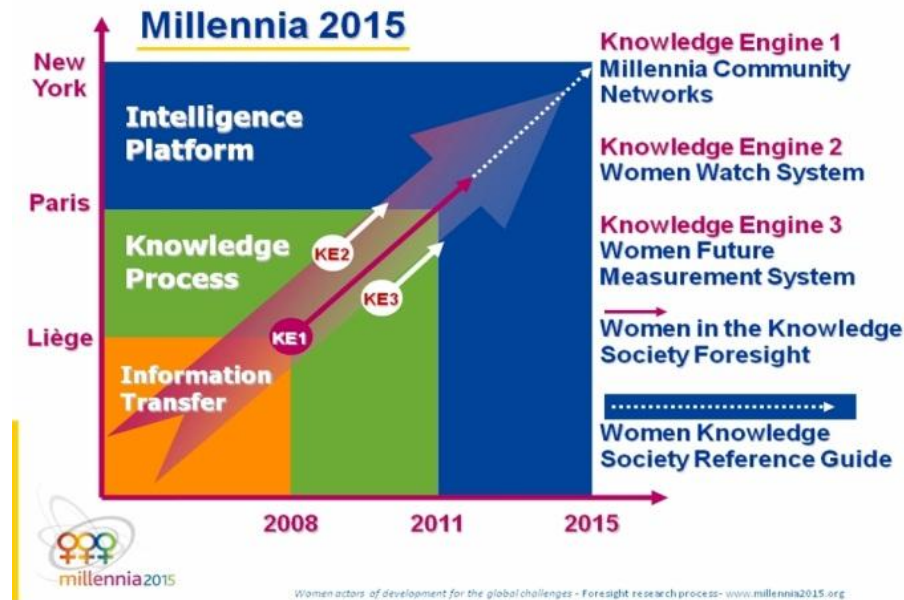
- **WeHealth** launched in August 2010 at the **European Research Destree Institute**, Namur, Belgium

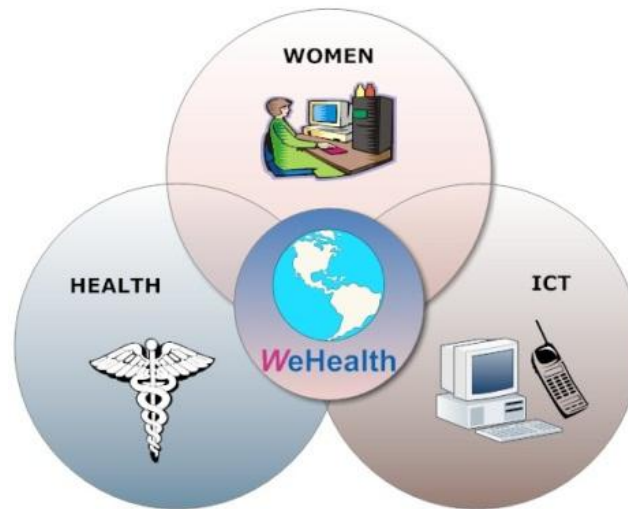

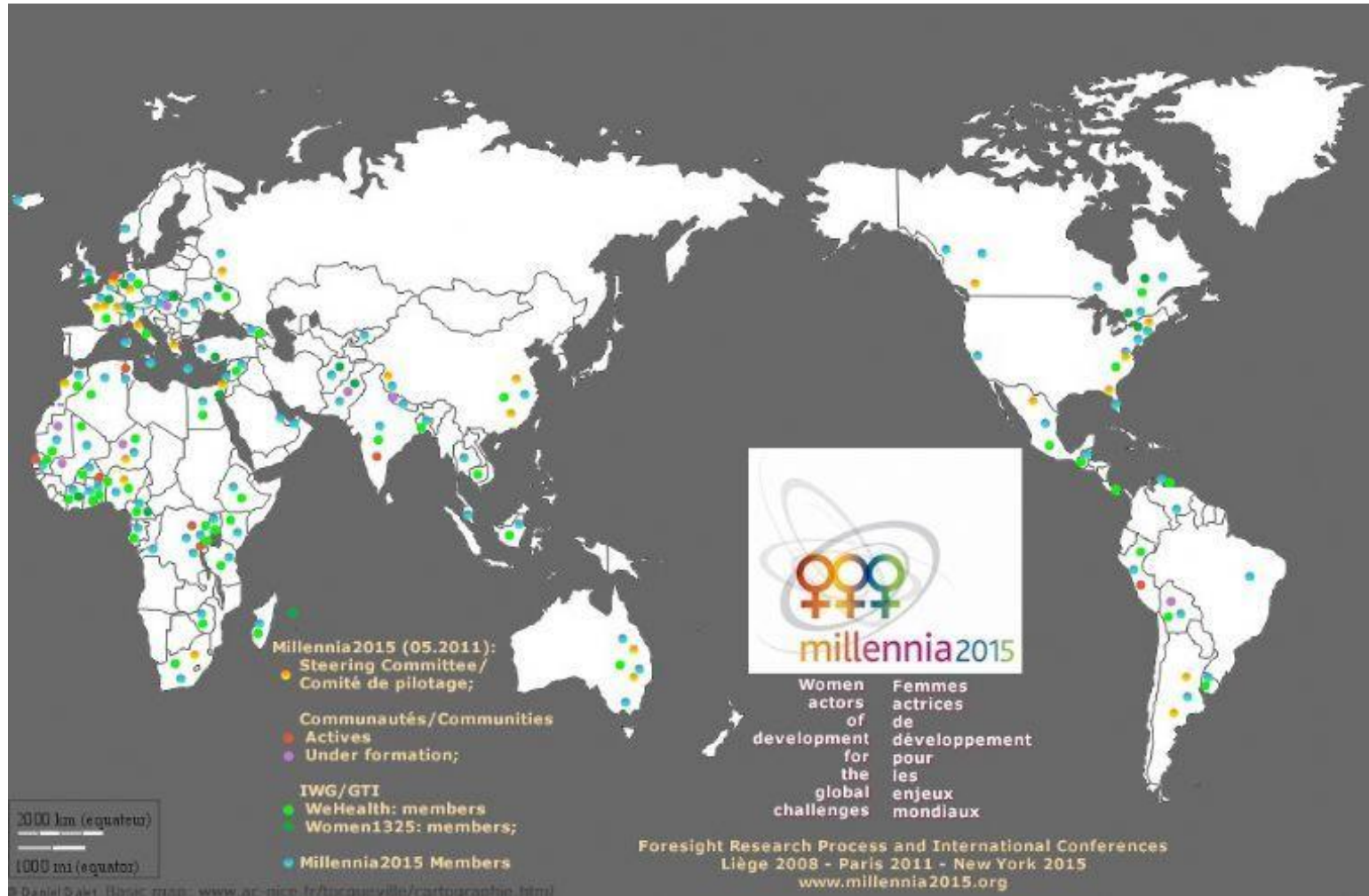

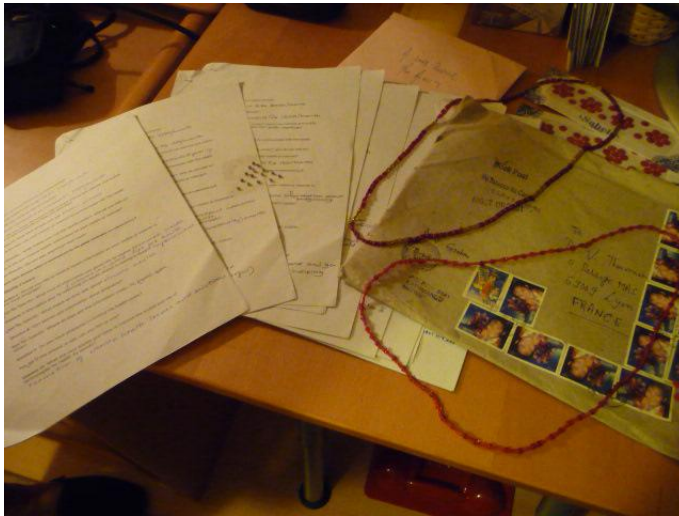
# WeHealth Voices
