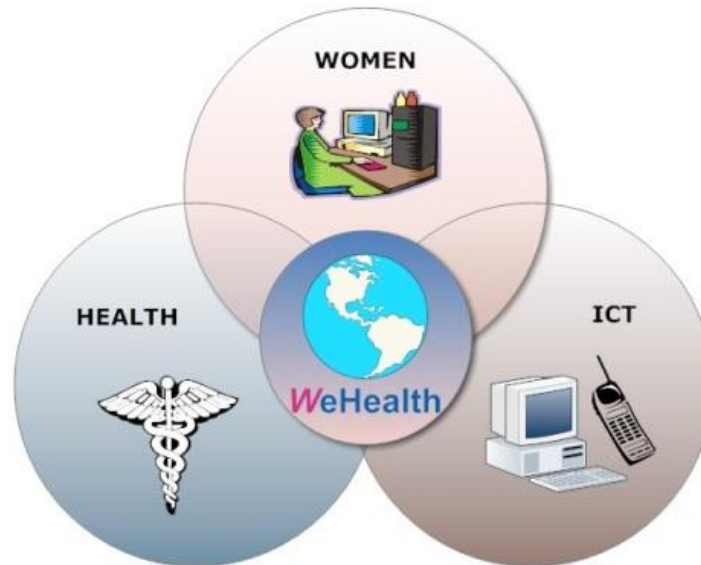

- *Accelerate Women's Leadership*

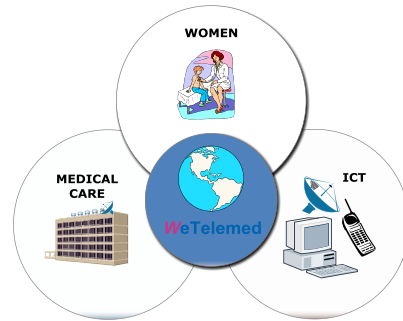

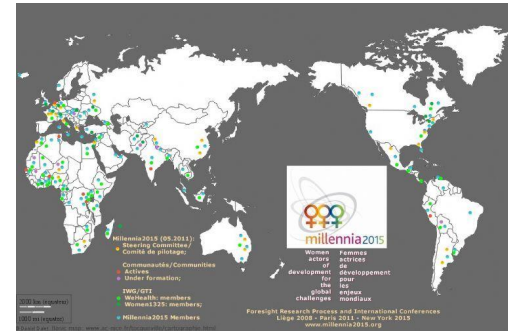
